







<b><u>RIBBON</u></b>	<b><u>AWARD</u></b>	<b><u>SELECTION CRITERIA</u></b>
	<b>Legion of Valor Bronze Cross for Achievement</b>	Award is submitted on a junior Cadet who is in the top 25 percent of Junior Class. Awarded to Cadet as a senior
	<b>MCROA Outstanding Unit Award</b>	Marine Corps Reserve Officer's Association (MCROA) for Outstanding MCJROTC Unit
	<b>American Legion Award for Scholastic Excellence Medal</b>	Awarded for Scholastic Excellence awarded to 1 Cadet at the end of the year who is in the top 10% of their class and has participated in at least 1 student activity or sport.
	<b>American Legion Award for Military Excellence Medal</b>	Cadet must be in the top 25 percent of the Class in academic standing. Cadet must have demonstrated outstanding qualities in military leadership, discipline, character and citizenship.
	<b>Sons of the American Revolution Medal</b>	Awarded to a Junior Cadet who has exhibited the highest standards of leadership, bearing and excellence.
	<b>Daughters of the American Revolution Bronze Medal</b>	Awarded to a Senior Cadet who is in the top 25 percent of class and has demonstrated dependability, military discipline and leadership. Selected by the SMI and principal.
	<b>Military Order of World Wars Bronze Medal</b>	Awarded at the end of the year to an outstanding 1st or 2nd year Cadet who excels in military and scholastic activities during the year.
	<b>Military Order of World Wars Leadership Ribbon</b>	Awarded to a Cadet who best exemplifies the Spirit of ROTC Leadership. Usually accompanied by a monetary award.
	<b>The Military Officer's Association of America Medal</b>	Presented to a graduating Cadet for having demonstrated exceptional potential for military leadership as a member of the MCJROTC.
	<b>Veteran of Foreign Wars JROTC Bronze Medal</b>	Presented for leadership in and out of uniform. Cadet must have a C avg in school academics. Must be involved in at least 1 extracurricular activity or club. 1 Senior, junior and sophomore Cadet is chosen by the SMI.
	<b>Daedalian JROTC Achievement Award</b>	Presented to a junior Cadet who has demonstrated an understanding and appreciation of patriotism, love of country and service to nation. Ranked in top 20% of junior class and looks to pursue a military career
	<b>Marine Corps League Distinguished Citizen Medal</b>	This award is given to a Sgt/below and SNCO who has assisted others in need, and promoted values of citizenship and patriotism. The award consists of the Distinguished Citizen Medal.
	<b>Woman Marines Association Outstanding Cadet</b>	Awarded to a 2nd year Cadet who has the highest Leadership Education Grade in the MCJROTC Unit
	<b>Noncommissioned Officers (NCOA) Association Medal</b>	Awarded annually to the Most outstanding Cadet NCO. Cadet must have the best military bearing, personal appearance, deportment and leadership ability. Can be any LE level.
	<b>Military Order of the Purple Heart Medal</b>	Awarded to a freshman, sophomore or junior Cadet who has given all for the MCJROTC Program and either had a moment in which the cadet did an outstanding job in a leadership position or is currently in a leadership position.
	<b>Reserve Officers Association Medal</b>	Awarded annually to a 2nd year Cadet that has demonstrated dedication to citizenship, outstanding MCJROTC knowledge, self discipline and has a sound work ethic,

	<b>American Veterans Medal</b>	<b>Awarded by the local AmVets Association</b>
	<b>National Sojourners Award</b>	Presented to Sophomore or Junior Cadet who is in the top 25% of class and has demonstrated the ideals of Americanism.
	<b>Scottish Rite Medal</b>	Awarded to a 3rd year Cadet in the top 20 percent of academic class and has demonstrated potential for outstanding leadership, dependability, self discipline and patriotism.
	<b>Outstanding Cadet Award</b> N-3-2	One award a year to the most outstanding cadet in any grade selected by the SMI.
	<b>Student Leadership Award</b> N-3-8	Awarded to students who are in student government
	<b>Officer Leadership Award</b> N-3-5	Awarded once a year to the Officer who demonstrates exceptional discipline and military bearing
	<b>NCO Leadership</b> N-3-4	Awarded once a year to a NCO for exceptional leadership, discipline and military bearing
	<b>Civic Service Award</b> N-4-4	For outstanding community service. The Cadet must have participated in more than 1 project.
	<b>Best Drill Cadet</b> N-3-1	One awarded a year to the cadet who performs best in drill with or without a rifle
	<b>Distinguished Scholastic Achievement Award</b> N-1-6	Annual to cadets that maintain an "A" average and or in the top 10 percent of their class and Honor Roll
	<b>Arts and Academics Award</b> N-1-9	Awarded to Cadets who are on the Arts National Honor Society
	<b>Distinguished Military Training</b> N-1-2	Awarded to Cadets who participate in Orientation successfully
	<b>Physical Training Team Award</b>	Awarded once a year for 90 percent participation on PT Team
	<b>Physical Achievement Award</b> N-2-9	Awarded once a year to cadets who score a first class on the YPFT.
	<b>Superior Marksmanship Award</b> N-2-1	Awarded once a year to the Cadet who is the high shooter.
	<b>Athletic Participation Award</b> N-1-8	Awarded to Cadets that participate on organized athletic teams for the school or community
	<b>Longevity/Fidelity</b> N-4-1	Awarded on subsequent years for participation in MCJROTC

	<b>Distinguished Conduct Award</b> N-3-9	Awarded to Cadets who did not have any disciplinary infractions for the previous school year.
	<b>MCROA Outstanding Unit Award (2nd Place)</b>	Unit Award
	<b>MCROA Outstanding Unit Award (3rd Place)</b>	Unit Award
	<b>Best Drill Squad Award</b> N-3-7	Awarded annually to the best drill squad of the Drill Team.
	<b>Color Guard Ribbon</b> N-3-3	Awarded to Cadets on the Color Guard or Flag Detail morning colors.
	<b>Orientation (Mini Bootcamp)</b>	Awarded to Cadets that complete one week of Orientation.
	<b>Recruiting Ribbon</b>	Awarded to Cadets for recruiting another Cadet into the MCJROTC Program
	<b>Drill Team Ribbon</b>	Awarded to Cadets of the drill team that participated in all practices and events.
	<b>Martial Arts Ribbon</b>	Awarded to Cadets who completed all requirements for the MCJROTC Tan Belt
	<b>Band w/Band device</b> N-3-10	Awarded to Cadets of the school Band
	<b>Rifle Team Ribbon, N-2-6, w/Rifle Team device</b>	Awarded to Cadets of the Rifle Team that participated in practices and rifle matches.
