As a Marine Corps Junior Reserve Officer Training Corps (MCJROTC) cadet (student) at Orange High School, I understand that I am entering a **one-year commitment** to the JROTC program and cannot be removed from the program until the following school year. I also understand that I need to bring the following to the JROTC program daily:

1. Come to class, on time, with a Positive Mental Attitude (PMA), work hard and complete assignments.
2. Meet specific grooming standards as explain later in this contract.
3. Participate enthusiastically in physical fitness training.
4. Take exams when given. (For example, after excused absence.)
5. When you are absent from class you are responsible for the work missed as per the monthly training calendar. You are also responsible for being prepared for any class instruction/Uniform Inspection/PT that is on the training calendar.
6. **Wear the uniform** to class once a week, normally Thursday, and on class trips.
7. Be ready for class by checking the monthly training plan and posted updates; have pen, pencil, paper, workbook, textbook, permission slips, readings or memory items done.

We hereby request that our child named above be permitted to take part in the MCJROTC program at Orange High School. We also acknowledge that during our child's enrollment, he/she may participate in demonstrations and exercises that may include the following:

1. Marksmanship training with .177 caliber pellet air rifles for the purpose of operation familiarization and safety procedures.
2. Military vehicle rides aboard military bases.
3. Air show demonstrations.
4. Endurance runs, hikes, and land navigation exercises.
5. Obstacle and confidence courses which may include obstacles of heights of up to twenty-five feet which must be scaled.
6. Demonstrations and video simulator use of military weapons for familiarization.
7. Rappelling from fixed towers or rock face.
8. Transportation of participants to and from orientation, events, or other activities. Transportation will be provided by car, van, bus, truck, military vehicle, or plane (if required).
9. Exercises in swimming pools to include swim qualifications and drown proofing.
10. Overnight bivouacing (camping).
11. Observation and hands on familiarity with military equipment to include static displays of tanks, aircraft. Logistics support equipment, and other pieces of military equipment.

It is our understanding that our child may participate in the above exercises and demonstrations or exercises and demonstrations of a related nature and that all such demonstrations and exercises will take place under the supervision and direction of the MCJROTC Instructors or qualified adults familiar with the safe operation of the above named devices. It is our understanding that all exercises and demonstrations will be conducted according to the normal and standard operating procedures in effect in the Marine Corps.

Nevertheless, we acknowledge that the normal and safe operation of the above name devices and exercises may involve inherent hazards and risks and we agree to hold the sponsors, Marine Corps and supervising individuals harmless and not liable for any injury or damage, either personal or that involving personal property, which may result from participation in the above named events. We further agree that neither the sponsors, Marine Corps or supervising personnel shall be liable for any injury or damage to person or property resulting from accidents involving the above named or related equipment, or the above named or related demonstrations and exercises where such damage or injury is the result of mechanical breakdown or fatigue. It is our understanding that the sponsors and Marine Corps will be responsible for normal maintenance and safe operation of all equipment within the guidelines and parameters of standard Marine Corps operating procedures.

Furthermore, we agree to assume full responsibility for any act of misconduct or negligence committed by our child in connection with any orientation or visit which may result in damage, destruction, or harm to any property or injury or death to any person or persons.

We further acknowledge that it is the responsibility of our child to cooperate with all supervisors and to follow those instructions and guidelines given to him/her concerning the safe and proper operation of any device or equipment or in the performance of any demonstration or exercise

WE UNDERSTAND THE INSTRUCTION OF ORGANIZED TACTICAL COMBAT TRAINING OF THE MCJROTC IS PROHIBITED.

We further declare that our child is covered by accident insurance and will be covered by accident insurance during the period of any described orientation or trip. We authorize a responsible adult to seek medical treatment and to take our child to a local doctor or emergency care facility for treatment and to transport him/her by ambulance if necessary. I understand that I am responsible for all financial cost of such treatment.

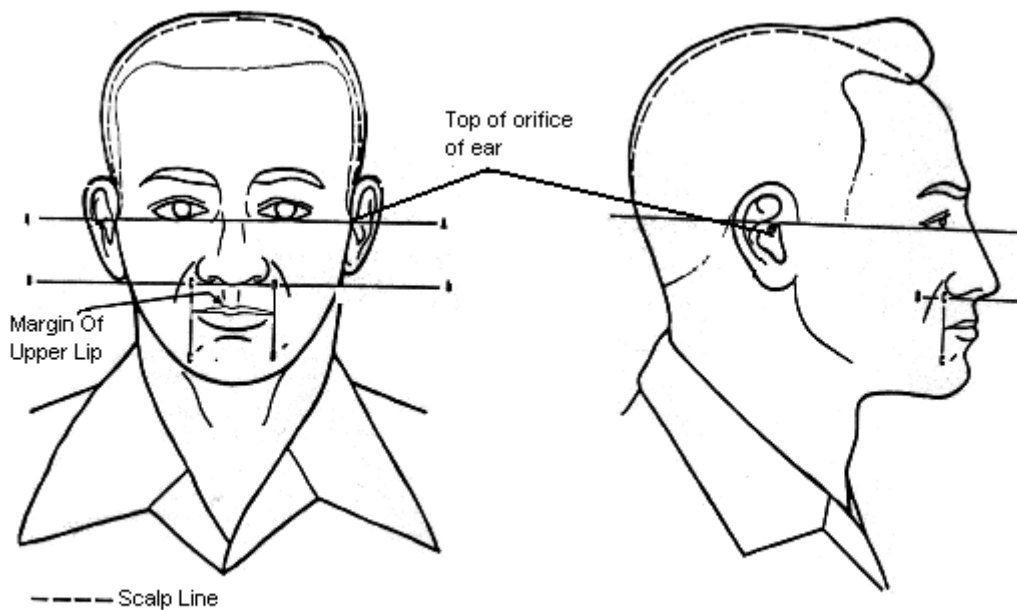

Grooming Standards

1. Articles not authorized for wear as a part of a uniform will not be worn with the uniform. Examples of such articles are: pencils, pens, watch chains, fobs, pins, jewelry, ribbons/ornaments, flowers or similar items.
2. Articles that may be worn while in uniform include conservative wrist watches and rings. Sunglasses may be worn but not in formation. Eyeglasses will be conservative in appearance eccentric eyeglasses are prohibited. Chains, bands or ribbons will not be attached to eyeglasses.
3. Cadets may wear religious articles that are not visible when worn.
4. Haircuts will be checked weekly. Failure to get a proper haircut or improper hair coloring (not fitting military standards) will result in a phone conference with your parent and a loss of merit points.
5. **Male cadet haircut standards:** (See picture below of Corporal A.J. Squared-Away)
 - Trimmed on sides and back so hair is graduated from zero to ½ inch. Hair cannot touch the ears and must be tapered, not blocked
 - Sideburns will not go below the top of the ear orifice (place your index finger in your ear, sideburns cannot go below the top to your finger.)
 - The hair on the top of the head will not exceed 3 inches. It will be washed and neatly combed. Hair will be a natural color.
 - Facial hair is not allowed, except for mustaches. Mustaches must be trimmed so that the hair does not fall below the top edge of the upper lip and does not extend past the mouth.
6. **Female cadet** hair will not fall below the bottom of the shirt collar. Hair pins will be hidden. Hair will be a natural color.

Females are authorized to wear plain gold or silver stud earrings (one on each ear) in dress uniform only.

Regulations & User Agreement Form For Marine Corps Junior Reserve Officers' Training Corps (MCJROTC) Government Computers

The Department of Defense, Department of the Navy and the United States Marine Corps provide regulations for the use of the government computers and other related information system technologies. In line with these official rules, the following MCJROTC units, District Project Officers, and seniors Marine Instructors at each school will be responsible to ensure that all instructors and cadets understand and abide by the rules governing the use of the MCJROTC computers.

All personnel are forbidden to access any pornographic material on MCJROTC computers.

No personnel will send or receive personal e-mail by way of MCJROTC computers.

No personnel will use the MCJROTC computers for real time communicating such as a chat room or instant messenger.

MCJROTC computers will not be used for shopping or to conduct any other such person ventures.

Chain letters of any kind will not be forwarded on MCJROTC computers.

Instructors and cadets will sign this MCJROTC Regulations and User Agreement Form prior to using the computer for any academic or other related MCJROTC work.

Senior Marine Instructor's will maintain current cadet signed Regulations and User Agreement Forms.

Project Officers will maintain current SMI/MI signed Regulations and User Agreement Forms.

I hereby certify that I understand and will comply with the above listed regulations pertaining to the use of MCJROTC government computers. I also understand that failure to comply with these regulations may result in my dismissal from the MCJROTC Program.
